AN ORDINANCE *MM-7*

AUTHORIZING THE PROJECT OF A DORMITORY FOR WORKING GIRLS AND FOR THE ALLOCATION OF \$90,000.00 BY THE UNITED STATES FOR ITS CONSTRUCTION UNDER THE NIRA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the project to construct a DORMITORY FOR WORKING GIRLS by the City of San Antonio, a Home Rule municipality under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas, incorporated in the year A. D. 1836, acting by and through its Mayor, C. K. Quin, on property of the City of San Antonio, and the allocation by the United States of America of the sum of \$90,000.00 to provide for its construction under the provisions of Section 202 and/or 203, 206, 207 and 208 of the National Industrial Recovery Act approved on the 16 of June, 1933, be and the same is hereby approved and authorized.

2. The Mayor of the City of San Antonio is hereby empowered and authorized to execute every deed, lease, contract, lien, mortgage, bond, note or certificate which is now required or which may be requited hereafter by the Administrator of Public Works appointed by the President, or such other agency of the United States in whom is vested the presidential function.

3. The application for a loan to the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works is approved as a part of this ordinance by reference as fully and to all intents and purposes as if it were copied in full here.

4. The City of San Antonio will pas such other ordinances which may be necessary to accomplish the completion of the project approved.
