SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO HELD IN
THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, ON
WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 23, 1957 AT 9:30 A.M.

PRESENT: DIETERT, PASSUR, WINTON, GAYOSO, OLIVARES, DANIELS, SAN MARTIN

ABSENT: KUYKENDALL, MCMAHON

The Clerk read the call of the meeting.

After invocation by Councilman Gayoso, the Clerk announced that the Bond Election returns were before the Council for the purpose of conducting the official canvass.

The Mayor Pro-tem then instructed that the canvass proceed with the City Clerk, his assistants and the council members conducting the check.

At the completion of checking all returns, the council stood at ease pending the totaling of votes on the adding machines.

The Clerk then announced the totals as verified were as follows:

PROPOSITION NO. 3

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF STORM SEWER AND DRAINAGE BONDS" 14,253 votes

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF STORM SEWER AND DRAINAGE BONDS" 12,052 votes

PROPOSITION NO. 4

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF NEW POLICE HEADQUARTERS BUILDING BONDS" 12,669 votes

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF NEW POLICE HEADQUARTERS BUILDING BONDS" 13,343 votes

PROPOSITION NO. 5

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PARKS AND RECREATION IMPROVEMENT AND EXTENSION BONDS" 12,178 votes

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF PARKS AND RECREATION IMPROVEMENT AND EXTENSION BONDS" 13,764 votes

PROPOSITION NO. 6

"FOR THE ISSUANCE OF U. S. HIGHWAY NO. 181, SOUTH EXPRESSWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY BONDS" 13,714 votes

"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF U. S. HIGHWAY NO. 181, SOUTH EXPRESSWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY BONDS" 12,340 votes

Councilman Winton introduced an ordinance and made a motion that it be passed. The motion was seconded by Councilman Passur. The ordinance was read in full by the City Clerk.

The motion carrying with it the passage of the ordinance prevailed by the following vote:

AYES: Councilmen Daniels, Dietert, Gayoso, San Martin, Olivares, Passur and Winton

NAYS: None

The Mayor announced that the ordinance had been passed. The ordinance as passed is as follows:
