

AN ORDINANCE

2011-12-08-1020

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND ALLOCATION OF ADDITIONAL GRANT FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$20,000.00 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY FOR THE SAN ANTONIO SOLAR AMERICA CITIES INITIATIVE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A SUSTAINABLE SOLAR INFRASTRUCTURE TO INTEGRATE SOLAR ENERGY INTO CITY PLANNING AND PROCESSES AND A COMMITMENT TO A LARGE-SCALE IMPLEMENTATION OF SOLAR TECHNOLOGIES THROUGH APRIL 30, 2012.

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WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Energy selected San Antonio, one of twenty-five major U.S. cities, as a Solar America City and Ordinance 2008-01-10-0015 authorized the acceptance of a \$200,000.00 grant from the Department of Energy's Solar America Cities Initiative; and

WHEREAS, since San Antonio's involvement in the San Antonio Solar America Cities program, over 14 megawatts (MW) of photovoltaic (PV) capacity has been established (through a power purchase agreement), CPS Energy has an additional 30 MW of PV currently contracted for development and has released a Request For Proposal for 400 MW of PV generation; and

WHEREAS, due to the success of the Solar America Cities Program, the Department of Energy has provided an additional award of \$20,000.00 to each Solar America City, for a total award of \$220,000.00, with a contract extension through April 30, 2012; the City has secured the required minimum 100 percent match with in-kind contributions from existing City contracts with Solar San Antonio and Build San Antonio Green, and a staff time match from the Office of Environmental Policy; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance authorizes the acceptance and allocation of additional grant funding in an amount up to \$20,000.00 from the Department of Energy for the San Antonio Solar America Cities Initiative; authorizes in-kind contribution of \$20,000.00, of which \$15,000.00 will be provided by outside agencies and \$5,000.00 will be provided by OEP; and authorizes a total program budget of \$480,000.00; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of Office of Environmental Policy (OEP) or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept additional funding in the amount of \$20,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Solar America Initiative Grant Program for development of a sustainable solar infrastructure and technologies and to extend the period through April 30, 2012. This amendment also calls for an authorization of an in-kind contribution of \$20,000, of which \$15,000.00 will be provided by outside agencies and \$5,000.00 will be provided by OEP.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or her designee or the Director of Office of Environmental Policy or his designee, is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said amendment.

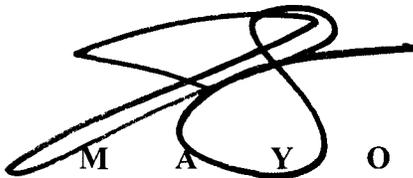
SECTION 3. Fund 2601455001 entitled "Solar America Cities SA 2015 - DOE 2008" and internal order 155000000033 is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this amendment. The updated budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

SECTION 4. The above designated fund is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this contract. Funds will be disbursed from GL 5202020 "Contractual Services" to Solar San Antonio, not to exceed the budgeted amount up to \$20,000.00 and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 5. The financial fiscal allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.

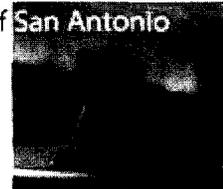
