

AN ORDINANCE **61323**

CALLING A REFERENDUM ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 5TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1985, ON ORDINANCE NO. 60767 WHICH DIRECTS THE WATER WORKS BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SAN ANTONIO TO PROVIDE FOR THE FLUORIDATION OF ALL WATER SUPPLIES WITHIN ITS DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM, AND AUTHORIZES SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO OFFSET THE COST OF FLUORIDATION.

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WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 60767 passed and approved on May 30, 1985, provided for the fluoridation of the public water supply by the City Water Board; and

WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the City Clerk on ^{August 14, 1985 (now)} ~~May 16, 1966~~, requesting that the aforementioned ordinance be repealed or submitted to a vote of the electors and the petition has been determined to be sufficient and in accordance with City Charter requirements for referendum petitions; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the Council by earlier action has voted in the negative on the question "shall the ordinance be repealed" and it is now necessary to call a referendum election and submit the ordinance to the electors; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. An election shall be held in the City of San Antonio on the 5th day of November, 1985, at which election a referred ordinance shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the City of San Antonio, said ordinance being substantially as follows:

"AN ORDINANCE 60767

DIRECTING THE WATER WORKS BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SAN ANTONIO TO PROVIDE FOR THE FLUORIDATION OF ALL WATER SUPPLIES WITHIN ITS DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM; AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO OFFSET THE COST OF FLUORIDATION.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio through State law and City Charter is empowered to take certain actions to protect the public health; and

WHEREAS, the fluoridation of the City water supply to 0.8 parts per million will enhance the dental health of the citizenry; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council directs the Water Works Board of Trustees of San Antonio to fluoridate the water supply within its distribution system to 0.8 parts per million.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to submit any grant and/or funding application to the Texas Department of Health for funds to help offset the cost of fluoridation."

SECTION 2. Said election shall be held at the polling places in the regularly prescribed voting precincts of the City of San Antonio between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 7:00 o'clock p.m., with voting and polling places to be later established.

SECTION 3. All qualified electors residing in the City of San Antonio shall be eligible to vote at said election.

SECTION 4. The ballots for said election shall have written or printed thereon the following:

SECTION 5. Notice of said election shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation pursuant to law. The manner of holding said election shall be governed by the laws governing such elections.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk is authorized to negotiate with the Bexar County Elections Administrator for holding the election jointly with the County election to be held on November 5, 1985, on proposed State Constitutional amendments. A contrat will subsequently be presented to the City Council for formal approval and adoption, if such is successfully negotiated.

SUBJECT: Fluoride Referendum Issue

SUMMARY

The City Council at its meeting on Thursday, August 22, 1985, directed the City Clerk to meet with the Bexar County Elections Administrator to negotiate a contract for an election on the fluoride petition. The Charter stipulates that the City Council vote on the question of repealing the ordinance prior to actually voting on calling the election.

BACKGROUND

On August 14th, Mr. C. A. Stubbs submitted to the Clerk an amended petition which after review was determined to be sufficient and was certified to the Council at its meeting on August 22, 1985. The Council is directed by the Charter to vote on the repeal of the ordinance and, if it is not repealed, then the election will be called on the issue.

This ordinance will also authorize the City Clerk to negotiate a contract with the Elections Administrator to conduct a joint election. I will prepare for Council's consideration subsequent ordinances dealing with polling places, absentee voting sites, etc.

FINANCIAL DATA

The joint election, if approved by the City Council, will mean that the City will share the costs of the election with Bexar County which will then reduce our costs to one-half, which is approximately \$100,000.

RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that the ordinance approving the joint election with the County be approved by the City Council.
