THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 1ST, A.D.1917. 4 P.M.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING ORDERED APPROVED.

----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

Proposition of the Alamo Printing Company to print the City Charter, furnishing the City with 200 copies free of charge, they reserving the right to print extra copies for sale, was read and accepted on motion of Commissioner Heuermann, duly seconded and carried.

Petition of Felix Betz, for permit to open meat market was read and referred to Board of Health.

Petition of R.L.Fromm for permit to erect canvas roof fronting E.Commerce, was read and referred to Building Inspector.

Petition of Wright Bros for permit to install electric light streamers across Soledad Street for a period of three weeks was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

No. 169            MB-939      AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$6048.65 to pay to City of San Antonio's proportion of maintenance of R.B.Green Memorial Hospital.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, that there be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund the sum of \$6048.65, warrant for which shall be made payable to the County Judge of Bexar County, to cover the City of San Antonio's proportion of the expense of maintenance of the R.B.Green Memorial Hospital for the month of August, 1917 as per approved statement filed by the County Auditor with the City Auditor.

No. 170            - 940      AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$652.05 out of the 1917 General Fund to pay Eva McIntosh for meals served City prisoners during month of October 1917.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Six Hundred, fifty two and 05/100 Dollars (652.05) or so much thereof as may be necessary be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund to pay Eva McIntosh for serving 3726 meals to City prisoners during month of October 1917.

No. 171            - 941      AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$769.84 to pay City's one half of cost of retopping and tarviating

Wilson Street.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Seven Hundred and Sixty Nine and 84/100 (\$769.84) Dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1916 General Fund to pay the City's one half the cost of retopping and Tarxiating Wilson , warrant to be made payable to Bexar County.

No. 172. *MB-942* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating the sum of Fifty one and 35/100(\$51.35) Dollars out of the Judgement Fund to pay Osceola Archer, District Clerk, Bexar County, court costs.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the judgement fund the sum of \$51.35 to pay court costs to Osceola Archer, District Clerk, as follows: Thirty two and 25/100 (\$32.25) Dollars for cause No. B-12193, W.M.Locke vs City of San Antonio, judgment by agreement October 31, 1917; and Nineteen and 10/100 Dollars (\$19.10) for cause No. 13408, M.A.Shropshire vs. City of San Antonio, settled and dismissed at the cost of the City October 8, 1917.

No. 174 *- 944* AN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Twenty Two and 50/100 (\$22.50) Dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1917 General Fund to pay Policeman Max Fues for the purchase of another uniform, the uniform heretofore worn by him having been torn up in disturbance on Houston Street.
