No. 72 **MC-1007** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$41.85 to pay E.A. Steitle for installing transformer, etc.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$41.85 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay E.A. Steitle for installing transformer and protector coils at Concepcion Road Pumping Station, for sanitary sewers.

No. 73 **- 1010** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating the sum of One Hundred and Twelve Dollars and Fifty cents (\$112.50) in payment of Band Concert held in Koehler Park on July 4, 1919.

No. 74 *MC-1011* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$83.00 to pay expenses of Legal Dept. trip to Dallas.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$83.00 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay the expenses of the Legal Department incurred on a trip to Dallas and return, in connection with the case of the San Antonio Public Service Company's application for seven cent street car fares.

No. 75 *-1012* AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$3961.00 for Special Weekly Pay Rolls.
