

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO HELD IN
THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, ON
THURSDAY, JANUARY 31, 1985.

The Special Meeting was called to order at 2:35 P.M. by the presiding officer, Mayor Henry Cisneros, with the following members present: BERRIOZABAL, WEBB, DUTMER, WING, EURESTE, THOMPSON, ALDERETE, HARRINGTON, ARCHER, HASSLOCHER, CISNEROS.

85-10 The Clerk read the following Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE 60,188

AMENDING THE CITY CODE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PLACING OF THREE-WAY STOP SIGNS AT FOUR INTERSECTIONS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY OF NOT LESS THAN \$1.00 NOR MORE THAN \$200.00.

Mayor Cisneros briefly explained the request of area neighbors who would like to have stop signs erected at four intersections to slow down the traffic in their neighborhood, near Burbank High School.

Mr. Eureste moved that the Ordinance be approved. Mr. Hasslocher seconded the motion.

Mr. Eureste briefly explained the request and spoke to distribution of his memo to the Council members on this matter. He noted that, even though City staff does not feel that the volume of traffic warrants stop signs, according to technical judgements in such cases, the neighbors feel the need for stop signs at the four locations to curb dragracing. He spoke of a dragracing tragedy in the same area several years ago, and stated that this request is the result of a series of community meetings in his District.

After consideration, the motion, carrying with it the passage of the Ordinance, prevailed by the following vote: AYES: Berriozabal, Dutmer, Wing, Eureste, Thompson, Alderete, Harrington, Archer, Hasslocher, Cisneros; NAYS: None; ABSENT: Webb.

There being no further business, the Special Meeting was adjourned at 2:40 P.M.
