

AN ORDINANCE **2008-09-04-0768**

RENEWING A FULL SERVICE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE SERVICES CONTRACT WITH CLEAN HARBORS ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC., AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$575,000.00 ANNUALLY.

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WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Department manages the Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Site for the City of San Antonio, an obligation of the City under the Texas Pollution Discharge Elimination System Permit, and Ordinance 2006-09-21-1091 authorized the execution of a Household Hazardous Waste Services Contract with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. for an initial contract term of one year, with options for two additional one-year terms; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to perform all acts necessary to exercise the second option with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc., and renew the agreement with a contract value not to exceed \$575,000.00 annually.

SECTION 2. Funding for this Ordinance is contingent upon approval of the FY 2009 Budget for Fund 55001000 Solid Waste Management, Cost Center 5556030001 HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE PROGRAM, General Ledger 5201040 Fees to Professional Contractors.

SECTION 3. If approved by council, payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.



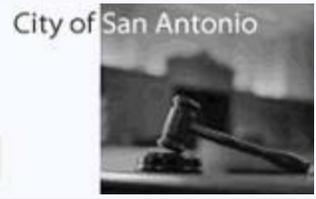

Contract extension with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc.

SUMMARY:

This ordinance authorizes the second of two optional one-year contract extensions of the 2006 Household Hazardous Waste Collection, Characterization, Packaging, Transportation and Disposal Services Contract with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. with the same terms and conditions and a contract value not to exceed \$575,000.00 annually.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Project Description

The Solid Waste Management Department manages the Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Drop-Off Site for the City of San Antonio, located at 7030 Culebra Road. At this site, citizens are able to dispose of household waste that may be toxic, corrosive, hazardous or flammable. Additionally, the site accepts used oil, batteries and paint.

The HHW program is a vital component for the Solid Waste Management Department and is a permit obligation of the City under the Texas Pollution Discharge Elimination System Permit.

Council Action History

Ordinance 2006-09-21-1091 authorized the execution of a Household Hazardous Waste Collection, Characterization, Packaging, Transportation and Disposal Contract with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. The initial contract term was for a period of one year, with options for two additional one-year terms.

ISSUE:

The current contract allows for two optional one-year extensions. Exercising this extension authorizes the City to continue household hazardous waste operations and compliance with federal and state environmental laws at the 7030 Culebra Road site.

The Solid Waste Management Department is proposing improvements for the Household Hazardous Waste Program for FY 2009. As a result of the budget process, the department will bring forward to City Council recommended changes to this program which will impact this contract. Any changes will be brought to City Council for approval.

ALTERNATIVES:

The current contract term expires on September 30, 2008. Should this extension not be exercised, the Department would be required to enter into the RFP process to obtain a new contractor. In the interim, waste disposal services would not be provided. Any delay may put the City in violation of environmental permit requirements.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of this ordinance will authorize the contract extension and expenditures not to exceed \$575,000.00 annually, allocated from the Environmental Services Fund.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the one-year contract extension requested by this ordinance.
