Mayor Chambers, introduced the following ordinance, which was read and passed and approved, on roll call by the following vote to-wit; Ayes, Chambers, Bushick, Rubiola, Steffler, Wright.

AN ORDINANCE

Revoking the approval of a petition of W. W. Knight to erect a Gasoline Filling Station.

1. WHEREAS, on the 5th day of January, A. D. 1928, W. W. Knight filed a petition for the erect of a gasoline filling station at the Northwest Corner of Cincinnati Avenue and Fredericksburg Road, the same to comply with all city regulations; and,
2. WHEREAS, the Commission of the City of San Antonio at its meeting of January 16, 1928; granted the application of W. W. Knight to erect a gasoline filling station at the Northwest corner of Cincinnati Avenue and Fredericksburg Road; and,
3. WHEREAS, it has been made appear to the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio that the said W. W. Knight has attempted to transfer said permit to the Humble Oil & Refining Company without permission of the City Commission, given after the filing of an application therefor; and,
4. WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio that the Humble Oil & Refining Company has begun to build a drive-in filling station within three hundred (300) feet of the Beacon Hill Baptist Church in violation of Section Ten of the Drive-In Filling Station Ordinance;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

5. That the City Commission in its discretion, because of the failure of the licensee, W. W. Knight, to comply with the ordinance of the City of San Antonio, does hereby revoke the permit issued to the said W. W. Knight on January 16, 1928.

6. By virtue of the necessity for the protection of the public safety, comfort and good government of the City of San Antonio, this ordinance shall take immediate effect upon its passage.
