

AN ORDINANCE 2009-10-01-0785

AMENDING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO'S MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN, A COMPONENT OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO MASTER PLAN, BY DE-DESIGNATING A PROPOSED SEGMENT OF THE NORTH & SOUTH CONNECTOR AND DESIGNATING AN EXTENTION OF RETAMA PARKWAY, BOTH GENERALLY LOCATED EAST OF NE LOOP 1604, NORTH OF I-35 AND SOUTH OF NACOGDOCHES ROAD.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio Major Thoroughfare Plan was adopted on September 21, 1978 by City Council as a component of the City of San Antonio Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on August 26th by the Planning Commission allowing all interested citizens to be heard; **NOW, THEREFORE;**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The Major Thoroughfare Plan, a component of the Master Plan of the City, is amended by de-designating a proposed segment of the North & South Connector and designating an extention of Retama Parkway, both generally located east of NE Loop 1604, North of I-35, and south of Nacogdoches Road. The Amendment is more particularly described in **Attachment "I"**, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect October 11, 2009.
