

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 28th, A. D. 1925, 4 P. M.

PRESENT: Honorable John W. Tobin, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Bushick, Lambert, Steffler, Wright.

Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved.

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A VEHICLE BRIDGE ACROSS THE SAN ANTONIO RIVER AT TEMPLE STREET.

1. WHEREAS, on the 31st day of August, A. D. 1925, an ordinance was passed permitting the San Antonio Belt & Terminal Railway Company to build a vehicle bridge across the San Antonio River at Temple Street;

2. AND WHEREAS, it has been made to appear to the Commissioners that it is not to the best interest of the public for said bridge to be constructed; NOW THEREFORE,

3. BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that the ordinance permitting the construction of a vehicle bridge across the San Antonio River at Temple Street, passed and approved on the 31st day of August, A. D. 1925, be and the same is hereby repealed, and all the provisions thereof are hereby revoked.
