Commissioner Steffler, introduced the following ordinance, which was read and passed and approved, by the following vote on roll call, to-wit; Ayes, Chambers, Bushick, Steffler, Wright.

AN ORDINANCE *MI-417*

APPROPRIATING \$25,000.00 AND AUTHORIZING THE ASSIGNMENT OF THE STREET IMPROVEMENT ASSESSMENT CERTIFICATES FOR THE EXTENSION OF RICHMOND AVENUE.

WHEREAS, an Ordinance was passed and approved on the 24th day of December, A. D. 1928, declaring the public necessity for the extension of Richmond Avenue and ordering that the cost of said improvement shall be discharged by assessing a part of the whole cost to the owners of property abutting, or in the vicinity of such improvements, the remainder of said cost not to exceed the sum of \$25,000.00 to be paid by the City of San Antonio; and,

WHEREAS, the property owners are now ready, able and willing to procure the conveyance of the necessary property to the City of San Antonio, upon the payment of the share of the City; and,

WHEREAS, this can be best accomplished by acting through a Trustee for the property owners:

NOW THEREFORE:-

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the sum of \$25,000.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street Opening and Widening Fund of 1928, and that a Warrant be issued to J. M. Slator, Jr. Trustee;
2. And that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to assign to J. M. Slator, Jr., Trustee, or to his order, all Street improvement Special Assessment Benefit Certificates issued under the procedure prescribed;
3. Which money and Certificates, or the proceeds thereof, shall be used by the said J. M. Slator, Jr., Trustee, for the acquisition of land by the City for this improvement.
4. Upon the delivery of the deeds, duly executed, conveying the land to the City, approved by the City Attorney, the City Auditor shall issue the Warrant above described, and the Mayor shall deliver the Benefit Certificates above described; subject to the stipulations of the

Charter and the Ordinances of the City of San Antonio.

5. PASSED AND APPROVED, this 30th day of January, A. D. 1929.
