AN ORDINANCE *MI-897*

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ASSIGN TO B. F. DITTMAR COMPANY CERTAIN STREET WIDENING BENEFIT ASSESSMENT CERTIFICATES FOR WEST TRAVIS STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and empowered to execute an assignment without recourse, of certain City of San Antonio Assignable Certificates of Special Assessment for street widening improvements on West Travis Street, between the West line of North Flores Street and the East line of North Santa Rosa Avenue; issued under the "Improvement Ordinance" and the "Special Assessment Ordinance for West Travis Street", and subject to the stipulations in said ordinances provided; said Certificates bearing the date of the 18th of February, 1929, and being more particularly described by number, name, amount, lot number and block number, as follows:-

Dittmar Company, without recourse; but subject to all the rights and remedies under the laws of the State of Texas and the Charter and the Ordinances of the City of San Antonio, made and provided governing the assignment thereof, and the rights of the assignee.
