ML-38 AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO RENEW NOTES ISSUED TO THE ALAMO NATIONAL BANK, FROST NATIONAL BANK AND THE CITY-CENTRAL BANK AND TRUST COMPANY FOR PAYMENT OF CURRENT EXPENSES FOR THE FISCAL YEARS 1928, 1929, 1930.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the City of San Antonio, acting by and through the Mayor, the Auditor and the City Clerk, is hereby authorized to execute an extension of notes issued to the City Depositories as follows:
