ML-49 AN ORDINANCE

TO ABANDON THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PAVING OF DEVINE ROAD FROM THE NORTH PROPERTY LINE OF HILDEBRAND AVENUE TO THE CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. WHEREAS, a certain Resolution ordering street improvement by the construction of paving on Devine Road, and certain other procedure to accomplish that purpose, was passed and approved by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio at a regular meeting held on the 23rd day of February, 1931, and recorded on the 4th day of March, 1932, in the Records of Deeds of Bexar County, in Book Volume 1299, on pages 123-124, and,

2. WHEREAS, the project has been abandoned and the improvement to the property for which the assessment was proposed has never been made.

3. That the aforesaid Resolution and all procedure under it be and the same is hereby repealed and that the City of San Antonio does hereby rescind any lien for the stipulated purpose on all those certain tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the City of San Antonio, County of Bexar, and State of Texas, more particularly described as follows:

4. Devine Road, from the north property line of Hildebrand Avenue to the City Limits; West Side: New City Block No. 6759, Lots 34, 35, 36, North part 36, 37, 38, South part 39, and 39; East Side: City Block A-52, O. C. L. 29 and 30, R. 1. D. 3.
