

AN ORDINANCE      2011-09-08-0735

**AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER IN THE INCREASED AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$546,800.00 TO THE AMOUNT OF THE CITY'S PORTION OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE FY 2010-2011 INDEFINITE DELIVERY CONTRACT (IDC) WITH PRONTO SANDBLASTING & COATING & OIL FIELD SERVICES CO., INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the FY 2010-2011 Indefinite Delivery Contract Package IV is utilized to construct street, drainage, traffic and pedestrian access related projects throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2010-04-01-0254 awarded an Indefinite Delivery Contract to **Pronto Sandblasting & Coating & Oil Field Services Co., Inc.** in the amount not to exceed \$3,198,370.00 for both City and San Antonio Water Systems (SAWS) bid items combined in connection with the 2010-2011 Indefinite Delivery Contract Package IV; and

**WHEREAS**, San Antonio Water Systems (SAWS) portion of the contract totaled \$1,010,970.00 for the necessary adjustments needed to their existing infrastructure and the City's portion of the contract is \$2,187,400.00; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance authorizes a change order in the amount not to exceed \$546,800.00 for the volume of current and future work consisting of construction services and other related services for various improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, this Change Order will increase the total not to exceed amount of the contract to \$3,745,170.00; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The Change Order in the increased amount not to exceed \$548,800.00 is hereby approved. The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute this Change Order to the contract with **Pronto Sandblasting & Coating & Oil Field Services Co., Inc.** for the FY 2010-2011 Indefinite Delivery Contract Package IV

**SECTION 2.** The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Funding for this Ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued from the potential funding sources. All expenditures will comply with Operating and or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.
- b) Payment in the amount not to exceed \$546,800.00 is authorized to **Pronto Sandblasting & Coating & Oil Field Services Co., Inc.** and should be encumbered with a purchase order.
- c) The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP

Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.






