AN ORDINANCE (1152) *MQ-705*

APPROPRIATING \$50.00 TO PURCHASE POST CARDS TO BE USED AS INVITATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

That \$50.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1939 General Fund - Stenographic Bureau Account, for the purchase of 5,000 post cards to be used as invitations for the Open House to be held at the City Hall on December 28th, 1939; said appropriation to be made in the name of The Postmaster, San Antonio, Texas.
