AN ORDINANCE *MN-25*

ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF ALAMO IRON WORKS AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY AND 95/100 OR AS MUCH OF SAID SUM AS MAY BE REQUIRED, OUT OF THE CITY HALL DEPARTMENT FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

The within proposal, insofar as it relates to 72 Boiler Tubes only, of Alamo Iron Works to furnish the City of San Antonio, City Hall Department, with 37 tubes 3" x 5' sum of \$61.79 and 35 tubes and the same is hereby accepted, and that the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter on said proposal an acceptance of same as above specified of and as the act of the City of San Antonio, Texas; and, that the sum of One Hundred eighty and 95/100, or so much of said sum as may be required, be and it is hereby appropriated out of the 1935 General Fund, City Hall Department, for the payment thereof.
