

AN ORDINANCE

PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION AT THE SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 24TH DAY OF JANUARY, 1950 AND THE PUBLICATION THEREOF AND AS PROVIDED IN ARTICLES 1165-1166 OF VERNON'S CIVIL STATUTES OF TEXAS OF THE QUESTION "SHALL A COMMISSION BE CHOSEN TO FRAME A NEW CHARTER"; AND PROVIDING FURTHER FOR A CHARTER COMMISSION AND THAT THE BALLOT OR VOTING MACHINE SHALL CONTAIN THE NAMES OF NOT LESS THAN FIFTEEN NOR MORE THAN ONE MEMBER FOR EACH THREE THOUSAND INHABITANTS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO BE VOTED ON AT SUCH SPECIAL ELECTION FOR SAID CHARTER COMMISSION FROM THE CITY AT LARGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

That at a special election to be held in the City of San Antonio on the 24th day of January, A. D. 1950, the question be submitted

"SHALL A COMMISSION BE CHOSEN TO FRAME A NEW CHARTER";

and be it further ordained that provision be made by the City Clerk for the election from the city at large of a Charter Commission of not less than fifteen nor more than one member for each three thousand inhabitants of the City of San Antonio; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance be published as required by law.


