

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, SEPTEMBER 16TH,  
1915, AT FOUR O'CLOCK, P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Garland, Lambert Kearny and Steves.

Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved.

MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS.

The petition for an arc' Light at North Flores and West Elmira Street, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Fire & Police, Steves.

The petition of Hermanns Soehne, protesting against the erection of garbage incinerator near cemetery, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Sanitation, Lambert.

On motion of Commissioner Garland, duly seconded and carried, Mrs. Glasscock was employed as Stenographer in the back-tax department.

The petition of H. S. Groesbeck, notice of employment by R. & L. Gastring, was read and ordered filed.

The petition of the Texas Granitoid Company, referring to error in street paving bid submitted August 30th, 1915, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements, Kearny.

The petition of H. Maubrey, protesting against the dumping of street sweepings in San Pedro Park, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Sanitation, Lambert.

The petition of citizens, protesting against the paving of South Flores Street, was read and ordered filed.

Bids for constructing bituminous roads in San Pedro Springs Park, submitted by Colglazier Construction Company and the Findley Method Company, were read and referred to the City Engineer.

On motion of Commissioner Lambert, hearing of property owners interested in the improvement of South Flores Street, from S.A. & A.P. Railway Company's Tracks to the Corpus Christi Road, were held. (See Record of Hearings, Page, 233.)

AN ORDINANCE.

*MA-223*  
Granting permission to F. Schleuning to construct a private sewer in Wicks Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section One. F. Schleuning be and he is hereby granted permission to construct a private sewer in Wicks Street, in accordance with the plans hereto attached, and in

accordance with all ordinances of the City now or that may hereafter be enforced.

Section Two. Said sewer shall be constructed at the expense of said F. Schleuning, and when completed shall become the property of the City of San Antonio, and a part of its public sewer system.

Section Three. That said F. Schleuning shall immediately file with the City Engineer a plat and statement of the cost of said sewer not exceeding however, the sum of Ninety (\$90.00) Dollars.

Section Four. That for every connection to be made with said sewer including connections made by said Schleuning, the City Engineer shall collect the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars for each connection, and such fee of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars shall be kept in a special fund until the amount collected on the basis of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars per each connection shall equal the cost of said sewer, when no further collection fee shall be charged or collected, provided however, that the City Engineer shall turn over to the said Schleuning the amounts collected during the proceeding month on the 10th month thereafter.

The petition of citizens requesting owners of property at Erie Avenue and Camden Street, to connect with sewers, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements, Kearny.
