BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the proposal of Nathan Alterman Electric Co., of 302 East Commerce Street,
San Antonio, Texas, for the construction of Feeder Circuit Wiring on the San Antonio River, as
per specifications on file in the office of R. H. H. Hugman, Architect, be and the same is
accepted hereby.

2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to require and approve on behalf of the
City proper bond for the performance and completing of said undertaking.

3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to cause and require the execution and
delivery of a written contract to be drawn in accordance with said proposal, and the terms
and conditions understood and required as applicable to said matter.

4. That to defray the costs and expenses to be paid by the City by reason of the
premises, \$5,383.00, or as much thereof as may be necessary, shall be and the same is approp-
riated hereby out Improvement District No. 15 Fund.

5. All other bids are hereby rejected.
