

AN ORDINANCE 2011-04-14-0301

AUTHORIZING THE AMENDMENT AND EXTENSION OF A CONTRACT WITH GONZABA MEDICAL GROUP FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE CITY'S EMPLOYEE HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio and Gonzaba Medical Group entered into an agreement pursuant to Ordinance No. 2008-05-01-0354, under which Gonzaba Medical Group provides administration and management of the City's Occupational Health and Wellness Center which includes drug testing, pre-employment physicals, job related vaccinations, care for employee illness and injury, and ancillary onsite services; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the Contract is an estimated annual amount of \$341,808.00; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the contract as set forth in the attached agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to execute the first extension to begin April 30, 2011 and end April 30, 2012; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City's Occupational Health and Wellness Center Contract with Gonzaba Medical Group is hereby amended as set forth in Attachment 1. This Contract is also extended for a one year period, from April 30, 2011 through April 30, 2012, as set for the in Exhibit 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute said Amendment and Extension. The terms of the Amendment and Extension are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Funding for this Ordinance is contingent upon budget appropriation in for Fund 75002000 Employee Wellness Program, Cost Center 1002050001 Occupational Health, General Ledger 5201040, Fees to Professional Contractors.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance becomes effective immediately if passed and approved by eight


(8) affirmative votes; otherwise this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from the date of passage.





**AMENDMENT AND FIRST EXTENSION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT
FOR ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND
WELLNESS CENTER**

This Amendment and First Extension of the Professional Services Contract for Administration and Management of the Occupational Health and Wellness Center (the "Contract") is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio ("City") and Gonzaba Medical Group ("Vendor"), and is as follows:

WHEREAS, through Ordinance No. 2008-05-01-0354, passed and approved on May 1, 2008, City Council authorized the execution of the Contract with Gonzaba Medical Group; and

WHEREAS, through Ordinance No. 2010-09-02-0755, passed and approved on September 2, 2010, City Council authorized the amendment of the Contract with Gonzaba Medical Group to provide post-accident drug and alcohol testing; and

WHEREAS, the Contract provides for a three-year term, beginning May 1, 2008, and ending April 30, 2011, with options to renew for two additional successive one-year periods; and

WHEREAS, with written notice prior to expiration of the term, City may at its sole option and through appropriate action of City Council, extend the term of the Contract for up to two, one-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to exercise the first renewal option to extend this Contract for a one-year period beginning on May 1, 2011, and ending on April 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to amend said Contract to add onsite pre-employment physical examinations and drug testing for the Parks and Recreation summer hiring process, add a mid-level provider, and modify terms related to random and reasonable suspicion drug testing, Medical Director requirements, meetings, health and wellness presentations, well-woman events, and the cost per rabies immunization; **NOW THEREFORE:**

I. AMENDMENT

A. Random and Reasonable Suspicion Drug Testing. Article II, SCOPE OF SERVICES, section 2.4.1, subsection 2, City of San Antonio Transportation Workplace Drug and Alcohol Testing Program (DOT) for positions that require a CDL, Random and Reasonable Suspicion Drug Testing, number 3 is revised by replacing "four (4) hours" with "three (3) hours".

B. Physical Examinations and Drug Testing. Article II, SCOPE OF SERVICES, section 2.4.2 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:

3. Onsite, pre-employment physical examinations and drug testing at City facilities for the Parks and Recreation summer hiring process at the City's request with three week notice given to Vendor. If events are performed at multiple City facilities, coordination between City and Vendor will occur so that one location is staffed at a time. More than one location may be involved in a day but will be timed to allow staffing of no more than one facility at a time.

C. Medical Director. Article II, SCOPE OF SERVICES, is amended in its entirety by replacing section 2.4.11 with the following:

2.4.11 Vendor will hire a physician as Medical Director to oversee dedicated facility who is Board Certified in Occupational Medicine through the American Board of Preventative Medicine; however, a physician with five (5) years experience in Occupational Medicine will be acceptable if a physician that is board certified in Occupational Medicine is not available;

D. Meetings. Article II, SCOPE OF SERVICES, is hereby amended by deleting section 2.4.16 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

2.4.16 Vendor will participate in meetings with City as needed or at the request of either party;

E. Health and Wellness Presentations. Article II, SCOPE OF SERVICES, is amended in its entirety by replacing section 2.4.19 with the following:

2.4.19 Vendor will provide six (6) health and wellness presentations per year for each year of the contract or as needed to include back care and injury prevention as well as other topics for City employees and will coordinate with City as to dates and times;

F. Well-Woman Events. Article II, SCOPE OF SERVICES, is hereby amended by deleting section 2.4.20 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

2.4.20 [Intentionally omitted]

G. Mid-level Provider. Article II, SCOPE OF SERVICES, is hereby amended by adding the following section:

2.4.36 Vendor will provide a mid-level provider at no cost to the City to decrease wait times and to meet the rise in patient volume.

H. Cost per Rabies Immunization. In Exhibit C, PRICING SCHEDULE, Core Services, section 3, Employee Immunizations, subsection k, the Cost per Rabies Immunization is revised by replacing "\$71" with "\$200".

II. RENEWAL AND EXTENSION

Pursuant to the provisions of section 6.1 of the Contract, City hereby renews and extends the term of said Contract for a period of one year, commencing on May 1, 2011, and terminating April 30, 2012, under the same terms and conditions as stated in said Contract and as amended in Section I of this AMENDMENT AND FIRST EXTENSION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT.

II. PROVISIONS REMAIN IN EFFECT

All other terms, conditions, covenants and provisions of the Contract approved through Ordinance No. 2008-05-01-0354 and as previously amended by Ordinance No. 2010-09-02-0755, not specifically mentioned herein and revised by this document, are hereby retained in their entirety, unchanged, and shall remain in full force in effect for the duration of said Contract.
