

A RESOLUTION

**INCORPORATING THE STRATEGIC HISTORIC PRESERVATION PLAN,
INTO THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND
DIRECTING THE OFFICE OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION TO MAKE
CHANGES TO THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE.**

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio ("City") has twenty-seven (27) historic districts; six River Improvement Overlay (RIO) Districts, over 1,200 individually designated local landmarks and more than 2,000 recorded archaeological sites; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to enhance the City's historic resources and further advance services to the public, the City sought the services of a consultant to develop a strategic historic preservation plan for the City's historic districts and individual landmarks; and

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2009, the Strategic Historic Preservation Plan was adopted by the San Antonio City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Strategic Historic Preservation Plan recommends changes to the City of San Antonio Unified Development Code; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby orders that the Strategic Historic Preservation Plan adopted on August 20, 2009, be incorporated and made a part of the City of San Antonio Comprehensive Plan.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby orders that the Office of Historic Preservation, through the Historic Preservation Officer, develop methods for incorporating recommendations of the Strategic Historic Preservation Plan into the City Code of San Antonio and present to the City Council a list of proposed changes to the Unified Development Code for their consideration.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.

PASSED AND APPROVED this 18th day of February, 2010.




