

**AN ORDINANCE            2012 - 12 - 13 - 1009**

**APPOINTING TEN MEMBERS TO THE CITIZEN  
ADVISORY ACTION BOARD.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3 of Article 29 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of San Antonio, Texas and the San Antonio Police Officers' Association approved by the San Antonio City Council on May 20, 2010, pursuant to Ordinance 2010-05-20-0452, City Council must select fourteen persons from a list of applicants provided by the City Manager to serve as members of the Citizen Advisory Action Board (CAAB) for two-year terms; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager and the Chief of Police must determine whether the persons on the list should be recommended; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio Police Officers' Association must determine whether the persons on the list should be recommended; and

**WHEREAS**, the list must be representative of the diversity of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, those on said list must meet the minimum qualifications established by Subsection 143.006(c) of the Texas Local Government Code for service on the San Antonio Fire Fighters' and Police Officers' Civil Service Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager submitted such a list and all of those on that list meet the minimum qualifications; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The following persons are hereby selected and appointed to serve as members on the CAAB:

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.




