BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the City of San Antonio does hereby accept the attached written proposal of Ed. Friedrich, Specification 1272, offering to furnish all material, labor and tools for the construction and completion of the Mechanically Refrigerated Freezer Display Counters at the City Market House, West Commerce and Santa Rosa Avenue, in and for the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, in accordance with the plans and specifications and drawings prepared and on file with the City Clerk;

2. Provided that said party making said proposal shall strictly comply with all requirements made by or under the provisions of this Ordinance and all instruments herein referred to, which are made a part hereof.

3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to require and approve on behalf of the City proper bond or bonds for the performance and completion of said undertakings.

4. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to cause and require the execution and delivery of a written contract to be drawn in accordance with said proposal, and the terms and conditions understood and required as applicable to said matter.

5. That the sum of \$17,382.00, or as much thereof as is necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Market House Fund, to pay Ed. Friedrich for furnishing all material, labor and tools for the construction and completion of the Mechanically Refrigerated Freezer Display Counters at the City Market House, West Commerce and Santa Rosa Avenue, in and for the City of San Antonio, Texas.

6. All other bids are hereby rejected.
