----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS----

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation:
E.P.Hays, for correction of assessment .
J.D.Scarbrough, for refund of Driverless Car License.
F.A.Hoecker, for correction of assessment.

Petition of Jose B.Elizondo for permit to install gasoline tank was read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Petition of property owners on Douglas Way requesting that it be macadamized was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets, etc.

Commissioner Wright made the following recommendations, which were adopted:
Sunset System, for permit to erect bulletin at Chestnut and Commerce Streets, granted.
Alamo Iron Works, for permit to install fuel oil tank, granted.

The City Engineer recommended that the bid of H.E.Gillette for building walk in Brackenridge Park be accepted. Adopted.

AN ORDINANCE

Providing for the transfer of certain funds.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

1. That the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) out of the Incinerator Building Fund of 1919, be transferred from the City Natl Bank of San Antonio, Texas, to the Commonwealth Bank & Trust Company of San Antonio, Texas.

2. That the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) out of the Bridge Fund of 1919 be transferred from the Commonwealth Bank & Trust Company, of San Antonio, Texas, to the City Natl Bank of San Antonio, Texas.

This transfer is made for the purpose of using Bridge Funds as a checking account in the General Depository of the City of San Antonio, the City National Bank. The City Auditor and the City Treasurer are hereby authorized to make above transfers.

Petition of Lakeview Improvement Club, requesting City to donate street south side of Euclid Park, for school building purposes, was read once and laid over.

A resolution authorizing and directing the City Engineer to lay out new road to be used as approach to Rock Quarry, was introduced and read, and defeated.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
