

AN ORDINANCE 2014-10-02-0753

AUTHORIZING THE SECOND AND FINAL ONE YEAR RENEWAL OF THE STAND-BY PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR LANDFILL COMPLIANCE, ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION AND CONSULTING SERVICES WITH HARTNETT ENGINEERED SOLUTIONS, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$155,000.00 FOR THE TERM OF THE RENEWAL, FUNDED BY THE SOLID WASTE OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE FUND

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WHEREAS, the City is required to perform activities with regard to solid waste and landfill compliance to comply with the environmental rules, regulations and guidelines set forth by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA); and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2012-08-16-0631 authorized the execution of a Stand-by Professional Services Agreement for Landfill Compliance, Environmental Remediation and Consulting Services with Hartnett Engineered Solutions, Inc. (HES), which provided for an initial contract term through September 30, 2013, with two optional one-year renewal terms, upon the approval of the City Council; Ordinance 2013-08-01-0503 authorized the first one-year renewal term of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes the second and final one-year renewal of the professional services agreement with Hartnett Engineered Solutions, Inc. (HES), for Stand-by Landfill Compliance, Environmental Remediation and Consulting Services, under the same terms and conditions, in an amount not to exceed \$155,000.00 for the term of the renewal, funded by the Solid Waste Operating and Maintenance Fund, to take effect upon Council approval and continue through September 30, 2015; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director, Solid Waste Management Department, or his designee, is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to exercise the second and final one year renewal option for the Stand-by Professional Services Agreement with Hartnett Engineered Solutions, Inc. (HES), for Stand-by Landfill Compliance, Environmental Remediation and Consulting Services, under the same terms and conditions, in an amount not to exceed \$155,000.00 for the term of the renewal. The renewal will take effect upon Council approval and continue through September 30, 2015.


SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$155,000.00 is contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget for Fund 55001000, Cost Center 5556030001 and General Ledger 5201040.

SECTION 3. If approved by council, payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Hartnett Engineered Solutions, Inc. and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
