**AUTHORIZING THE EBMS SOFTWARE LICENSE
ADDENDUM TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES
AGREEMENT WITH UNGERBOECK SYSTEMS
INTERNATIONAL FOR EVENT BUSINESS
MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT
OF \$13,912.50.**

WHEREAS, in July 1999, City Council approved a professional services agreement (“Agreement”) with Ungerboeck Systems International (“Ungerboeck”) through the passage of Ordinance No. 90078, dated July 22, 1999, for the purchase of Ungerboeck’s proprietary Event Business Management Software (“EBMS”) for the Convention Facilities and the Convention and Visitors Bureau (“CVB”); and

WHEREAS, the EBMS system was further enhanced when City Council passed Ordinance No. 93169 on January 4, 2001, approving an amendment to the Agreement which provided additional service packets, customization and training and again when City Council passed Ordinance No. 98949 on March 11, 2004, approving another amendment to the Agreement which provided the Alamodome with access to the EBMS system; and

WHEREAS, EBMS is a comprehensive enterprise system for the convention and tourism industry which integrates booking and event management providing a unified and seamless database for simultaneous access by the Convention, Sports and Entertainment Facilities Department and the CVB and manages information for all venues operated by both departments, including the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center, Lila Cockrell Theater, Municipal Auditorium and the Alamodome; and

WHEREAS, this proposed Ordinance approves an addendum to the Agreement (“Addendum”) providing for the purchase of two additional component packages entitled Bulletin Management and Membership Directory which are critical additions that will allow the CVB to better service both client and partner needs; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The terms and conditions of the EBMS Software License Addendum to the Professional Services Agreement with Ungerboeck Systems International for Event Business Management Software, for a total amount of \$13,912.50, are authorized and approved.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or her designee is authorized, for a sixty-(60) day period following the effective date of this Ordinance, to execute the EBMS Software License Addendum to the Professional Services Agreement. A copy of the Addendum, previously executed by Ungerboeck, is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit I.

SECTION 3. Funding for this Ordinance is available in Fund 29006000, entitled "HOTEL MOTEL TAX FUND," Cost Center 4302030001, entitled "Information Technology," General Ledger 5304075, entitled "Computer Software," as part of the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 budget.

SECTION 4. Payment not to exceed \$13,912.50 is authorized to Ungerboeck Systems International and shall be encumbered with a purchase order.


SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage.



EBMS Software License Addendum

This Addendum shall attach to the Software License Agreement between Ungerboeck Systems International, Inc. (USI) and City of San Antonio - San Antonio CVB (CLIENT) dated November 15, 1999. In the event of a conflict between the two documents, this addendum shall prevail. All other terms and conditions apply.

Client will add iEBMS Web Services perpetual license to existing system at a one-time fee of \$5,500 for up to 10,000 transactions per year. Upgrades to this transaction level are available as follows. Prices may vary at time of future licensing.

Up to 25,000	\$13,400
Up to 50,000	\$22,800
Up to 100,000	\$35,700

Additional levels provided upon request.

USI will invoice on acceptance of this addendum, and set an iEBMS configuration meeting with a consultant upon payment.

Annual maintenance and support on iEBMS Web Services license is charged as an annual fee of fifteen percent (15%) of the list license fee then charged to new customers for the then current version of the product.


First annual maintenance fee of \$825 will be prorated to coincide with renewal of existing EBMS modules through October 1, 2007 and will be invoiced upon receipt of payment for license. Prorated amount will be calculated at \$68.75 per month for an anticipated total of \$412.50 covering the period April 1 - September 30.

In conjunction with iEBMS Web Services license, Client will purchase iEBMS Web Services Implementation Packages for online Bulletin Management and online Membership Directory at a total cost of \$8,000. Packages include Consulting Support for one year from initial configuration planning.

BACKGROUND:

Ungerboeck Systems International (USI) has developed a comprehensive and seamlessly integrated Event Business Management System (EBMS). EBMS is an industry based software application with various operating features - in particular, simultaneous access for booking facilities and managing critical data for group meetings. EBMS affords the City a unified database containing customer information between the Convention Sports and Entertainment Facilities and Convention & Visitors Bureau (CVB).

POLICY ANALYSIS:

Further customer service integration drove two additional component packages which were negotiated within this agreement. The Bulletin Management and Membership Directory packages will allow the CVB to better service client and partner needs.

CONTRACT FORMAT:

The attached Addendum is for acquisition of user licenses associated to these augmented packages as well as an annual maintenance fee.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:


In Fiscal Year 2006-2007, the CVB has programmed \$13,912.50 for the negotiation of this program. All funds are derived from the Convention and Visitors Bureau Fund. There is no impact to the City's General Fund.



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

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
