

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, MARCH 16TH, A. D. 1916, 4. P. M.

PRESENT: Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Lambert and Kearny.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

-----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS-----

Petition of Fiesta San Jacinto for use of Plazas and Streets of the City for celebration, from April 24th to April 29th, inclusive, was granted on motion duly seconded and carried.

Petition of Arkansas & Miss. Grocery Co. for permit to install gasoline equipment at 236 San Pedro Avenue, was read and referred to Building Inspector.

Petition of Wm. Davison for refund of taxes was read and referred to Commissioner Garland.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner Lambert:
 Petition of M. Sosa for permit to conduct a meat market at 934 Ruiz Street.
 Petition for water mains in New Braunfels Avenue.

Commissioner Garland recommended that the petition of J. T. Connor for permit to erect garage in alley between Avenue "D" and "E" be granted. Adopted.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, a hearing of property owners interested in the improvement of Camden Street, previously called for this day, was opened.

There being no one present to object to the proposed improvement or the assessment to be levied therefore on motion of Commissioner Kearny the hearing closed.

Commissioner Kearny recommended that the petition of A. Kronkesky for reduction of assessment account of Street paving on Military Plaza be not granted. Adopted.

Commissioner Kearny introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Brown, Garland, Lambert and Kearny. Nays, none.

AN ORDINANCE *MA-157*

Appropriating \$504.20 to pay San Antonio Portland Cement Company.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That, the sum of Five Hundred and Four and 70/100 (\$504.70) Dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street Paving Fund to pay the San Antonio Portland Cement Company for cement used in constructing flat crossings in Brachenridge Park.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.
