AN ORDINANCE

DESIGNATING EACH MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL
AS MAYOR PRO TEM FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD
DURING THE 2005-2007 TERM.

WHEREAS, Section 9 of the City of San Antonio City Charter provides for a Mayor Pro Tem to act as Mayor during the absence or disability of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, a tradition has been established of rotating the Mayor Pro Tem position among all of the members of the Council, other than the Mayor, during the two-year term;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The following named members of the City Council are hereby designated as Mayor Pro Tem of the City of San Antonio to serve during the periods indicated below:

June 23, 2005 through September 2, 2005	Art A. Hall
September 3, 2005, through November 13, 2005	Roger O. Flores
November 14, 2005 through January 24, 2006	Elena Guajardo
January 25, 2006 through April 6, 2006	Kevin Wolff
April 7, 2006 through June 17, 2006	Patti Radle

SECTION 2. Council Member Art Hall, District 8, is hereby sworn in as Mayor Pro Tem for the period beginning June 23, 2005 through September 2, 2005.


SECTION 3. Should any of the above Council Members be replaced for any reason, such replacement shall be substituted for such member for the term indicated.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect on June 23, 2005, if approved by eight (8) or more affirmative votes; otherwise, said ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day from the date of passage hereof.

SUBJECT: Mayor Pro Tem Terms for 2005-2007 City Council
DATE: June 23, 2005

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION:

This ordinance shall designate the members of the 2005-2007 City Council as Mayor Pro-Tem for specified periods of time from June 23, 2005 through June, 2007 when new Council members are elected.

The terms are identified on Attachment I, and shall be drawn by lots by the City Council members in order to designate each with their respective term.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage with eight (8) affirmative votes.

POLICY ANALYSIS:

Section 9 of the City Charter calls for a Mayor Pro Tem to act as Mayor during the absence of the Mayor. Past practice has been to rotate the Mayor Pro Tem position among all the members of the City Council during each two-year term.

COORDINATION:

This ordinance was coordinated with the City Manager's Office and the City Attorney's Office.
