

AN ORDINANCE 2009 - 12 - 03 - 0977

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000.00 TO EACH OF FOUR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS WITH CLAUNCH & MILLER, INC., KLOTZ ASSOCIATES, INC., LOCKWOOD, ANDREWS & NEWNAM, INC. AND VICKREY & ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR ON-CALL PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES, FOR A TOTAL UP TO \$500,000.00 FOR EACH CONTRACT.

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WHEREAS, professional services agreements with **Claunch & Miller, Inc. Klotz Associates, Inc., Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc. and Vickrey & Associates, Inc.** in the amount of \$250,000.00 to each consultant to provide the City with professional engineering services on an as-needed basis were authorized by Ordinance No. 2008-02-14-0110; and

WHEREAS, the term of these agreements is for a one (1) year with options to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance will increase the agreement for each consultant in the amount of \$250,000.00 for each of the remaining two years, not to exceed \$500,000.00 for each agreement; and

WHEREAS, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy ensuring that capital improvement and maintenance projects are constructed in accordance with plans and specifications in a time efficient manner; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The agreements with **Claunch & Miller, Inc., Klotz Associates, Inc., Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc. and Vickrey & Associates, Inc.** are hereby amended to increase the agreement for each consultant in the amount of \$250,000.00 for on-call professional engineering services in connection with City-Wide Projects.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued from the potential funding sources. Potential funding sources include but are not limited to the 2007-2012 Bond Program, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, Advanced Transportation District (ATD) funds, Housing and Urban Development (HUD) 108 Loan Program funds, Certificates of Obligation, General Obligation Improvement Bond funds, Neighborhood Access and Mobility Program (NAMP), and Aviation Revenue Funds. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.

SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed the limitations of the budgeted amount is authorized and should be encumbered with a purchase order.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.


