THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 11TH, A.D.1919, 4 P.M.

To have gravel placed on Cassiano St.
To have Panama Avenue drained.
To have East Ashby street tarviated.

Bid of American La France Fire Engine Co. to furnish one turret pipe for the use of the Fire Department was referred to Purchasing Agent.

RESOLUTION

Authorizing purchase of air compressor and air receiver for street maintenance department.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the bid of the San Antonio Machine & Supply Company, dated Sept 8th, 1919, to supply the City of San Antonio with one Ingersoll-Rand air compressor and one air receiver for \$576.17 be and is hereby accepted.

AN ORDINANCE *-66*


Appropriating \$240.00 to pay sundry merchants bills.


