

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, OCTOBER 14TH, 1915,
AT FOUR O'CLOCK, P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Albert Steves, acting Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners, Garland, Lambert and Kearny.

Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved.

- - - - - MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS. - - - - -

The petition of A. Rogio, protesting against the paving of Santa Rosa Avenue, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements, Kearny.

The petition for Arc' Lights at Houston and Calavaras Streets, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Police & Fire, Steves.

The petition for water mains on Wyoming Street was read and referred to the Commissioner of Sanitation, Lambert.

The petition for water mains in Dittmar Avenue, was read and referred to the Commissioner of Sanitation, etc., Lambert.

The petition for paving West Myrtle Street, from San Pedro Avenue to North Flores Street, was read and ordered filed.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of Sixty Seven (\$67.26) Dollars and Twenty-Six Cents or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1915 General Fund to be used in paying transportation and other expenses of John Francis between Trenton, New Jersey, and San Antonio, Texas; said John Francis having been engaged by the City of San Antonio to assist in the construction of a golf course in Brackenridge Park.

Appropriating out of the 1915 General Fund the balance necessary for payment to Alexander Joske for property used for widening of West Commerce Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of Four Hundred and Eighty One (\$481.72) Dollars and Seventy Two Cents, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1915 General Fund to be transferred to the West Commerce Street Widening Fund to complete the amount necessary to pay Alexander Joske for land taken and damages accruing from the Widening of West Commerce Street, between Main Avenue and Santa Rosa Avenue, and that a certain ordinance of similar purpose passed in September 30th, 1915 be and the same is hereby repealed;

And that the sum of Ten Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-Five (\$10,875.00) Dollars including said Four Hundred Eighty One (\$481.72) Dollars and Seventy-Two Cents, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of said West Commerce Street Widening Fund to pay to said Alexander Joske for said purpose, upon execution and delivery of proper deed and papers approved by the City Attorney.
