Appropriating \$903.65 to pay Paul Hansen for work on certain streets.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

Section 1. That the sum of \$570.35 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay Paul Hansen for work done in putting down base on Florida Street, as per itemized statement on file in the office of the City Auditor.

Section 2; That the sum of \$333.30 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay Paul Hansen for grading done on Clifford Court, as per itemized statement on file in the office of the City Auditor.

Appropriating \$220.60 to pay sundry merchants bills.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of two hundred, twenty and 60/100 dollars, (\$220.60), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1919 General Fund to pay sundry merchants bills per itemized bills on file in office of City Auditor.

Fixing the creek limits and boundaries between certain streets and as shown by maps in City Engineers office, for the purpose of providing right-of-way to and from said creek, said right of way being found necessary to make possible the cleaning of said creek, the removal of drift, also the building and maintaining of retaining walls, dykes, etc. for the prevention of floods.
