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
An ordinance granting a franchise to Texas Transportation Company to use certain streets for a Freight Street Railway Line for the period ending on the 1st day of September, 1957, was read in full for the first time at a meeting of the Commissioners on August 5, 1947, and ordered advertised.

Commissioner Knight made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Davis, that the bid of L. D. Ormsby for \$7,100.00 for Lot on Nueva Street, described as Lot 2A, N.C.B. 179, be accepted as the highest bid, and that the City Attorney draw the necessary papers to transfer the land to him and that the Mayor be authorized to sign a Quit Claim Deed therefor. The motion carried by roll call vote, to-wit; Callaghan, Davis, Knight and South. Com. Hein being absent was voted as, no.


A leave of absence was voted Commissioner Hein until August 1, 1947.
