---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The City Attorney submitted the following opinion with reference to property owners connected with sewers on San Francisco Street.

To the Mayor and Commissioners
of the City of San Antonio,
Building.

Gentlemen:-

With reference to the attached list of property owners connected with sewers on San Francisco Street, and in reply to the request of an opinion "as to the right of the City to cut off this sewer if the owners of property connecting with same fail or refuse to pay annual rental for use of same";

I write to say that when there is a surplus capacity in the City system of sanitary sewerage and where there is a line outside of the city limits, the City may permit a connection and take the sewage, but it is the duty of the City to collect compensatory rental under such stipulations as the City may choose to fix.

If the Licensee does not pay the utility rental, the City may disconnect at the pleasure of the governing body, because persons living outside of the city limits have no right to use municipal facilities created by the expenditure of tax money.

In order to facilitate the handling of this business I take liberty to suggest that a connection permit be required of every user under a written application and that a survey be made to establish every connection and every person entitled to a permit.

Awaiting the opportunity of being of further service to you in this matter, I beg to remain.
