At this time the City Clerk read the following veto letter from the Mayor.

San Antonio, Texas,
December 1, 1950.

To the Board of Commissioners
of the City of San Antonio.

Sirs:

This is to notify you that, under the power and right vested in me as Mayor by Sec.26, Paragraph 1, of the Charter of the City of San Antonio, I disapprove of the ordinance "Ordering the City CLERK TO FORTHWITH PROCEED WITH THE ELECTION TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO IN ACCORDANCE WITH RESOLUTION PASSED OVER THE MAYOR VETO ON AUGUST 17, 1950, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ORDINANCE ORDERING THE ELECTION PASSED NOTWITHSTANDING THE VETO OF THE MAYOR ON AUGUST 3, 1950; AND ORDERING THE CITY CLERK TO COUNT ALL VOTES OF QUALIFIED VOTERS, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT THEY ARE CAST BY ONLY THOSE ENTITLED TO VOTE ON THE ISSUANCE OF TAX SUPPORTED BONDS", passed the 29th day of November, A. D. 1950, presented to me for my approval; and I hereby specify in writing, my objections thereto, for the following reasons:

1. On the 28th day of November, 1950, the Honorable Austin F. Anderson, at the request of the City Clerk, delivered to the City Clerk an opinion in which he held that only qualified voters of this city entitled to vote on a question of issuance of tax supported bonds could legally vote in the election called for December 19, 1950.

2. Because the City Clerk should be allowed to reply on and follow the advice given to him by the City Attorney, so that a legal and valid election might be held, and so that the hard-earned dollars of our innocent city employees will not be wasted further.

3. I further object to this proposed Ordinance because it is a shameless but futile effort to amend by ordinance, not only the charter of this City and the Statutes of the State of Texas, but even the Constitution.

4. Because this proposed ordinance seeks to deny the Mayor of San Antonio the right given him by Section 26, Paragraph 1, of our charter, to veto any ordinance, resolution or motion of the Board of Commissioners if he shall disapprove of it; and Paragraph 2 of this same section emphatically states that such a veto "shall suspend the act of the Board of Commissioners for seven (7) days."

5. I also object to this proposed Ordinance because I believe that where the taxpayers have to foot one-half of the cost of establishing a retirement system, they, and only they, should be the sole judges of whether this should be done by their City.


