

AN ORDINANCE 2014 - 03 - 06 - 0131

AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,953,635.00 TO VERTEX CORPORATION, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF RIGSBY BULKY WASTE RESIDENTIAL DROP-OFF CENTER, A SOLID WASTE CONTINGENCY FUND FUNDED PROJECT LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2.

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Department constructed two bulky waste residential drop-off centers in FY 2013 to help reduce illegal dumping and provide residents with a convenient opportunity to dispose of bulky waste at no cost; and

WHEREAS, City Council approved the construction of two additional Bulky Waste Residential Drop-Off Centers for FY 2014 that will be constructed in the western and eastern sections of the City for a total of four Bulky Waste Residential Drop-Off Centers, one in each quadrant of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Project provides for construction of a 2,800 square-foot crew quarters building to include offices, a large workroom, a technician's room, lockable closet, a custodian room, IT/Security room, a women's toilet/locker room, a men's toilet/locker room; and

WHEREAS, the work includes fixed roof canopies and fabric canopies, retaining walls, pavements, sidewalks, utilities, fences and gates, landscaping, irrigation, site work, lighting, fire protection, electrical, mechanical, plumbing, information technology, security, and associated improvements; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by **Vertex Corporation** in the amount not to exceed \$1,953,635.00 for the construction of the Rigsby Bulky Waste Residential Drop-Off Center Project; and

WHEREAS, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved 2012-2017 Solid Waste Contingency Fund funded projects; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid of **Vertex Corporation** in the amount not to exceed \$1,953,635.00 for the construction of the Rigsby Bulky Waste Center Project is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2. A construction contract is hereby awarded to **Vertex Corporation**.

SECTION 3. The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Payment in the amount not to exceed \$1,953,635.00 in SAP Fund 55099000, Environmental Capital Project, SAP Project Definition 55-00026, Bulky Waste Collection-Drop Off Cntr #4, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to **Vertex Corporation**, for construction services.

- b) The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
