Mayor Quin, introduced the following ordinance, which was read and passed and approved by the following vote on roll call, to-wit; Ayes, Quin, Bushick, Rubiola, Steffler, Wright.

AN ORDINANCE

AGREEING TO THE EXCHANGE OF LAND WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR THE WIDENING OF NORTH ALAMO STREET AND THE STRAIGHTENING OF EAST HOUSTON STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the City of San Antonio agrees to an exchange of property with the United States Government for the widening of North Alamo Street and the straightening of East Houston Street, in New City Block 425; said lands to be **exchanged** are described substantially as follows, subject to an accurate re-survey:

2. The United States will convey to the City of San Antonio a tract of land 10 feet wide and approximately 308 feet long, off of the Postoffice property on the east side of North Alamo Street, between East Houston Street and East Travis Street, said land to be used for the widening of North Alamo Street and containing approximately 3088 square feet, and a triangular tract of land on East Houston Street containing approximately 110 feet; a plat reflecting the above figures and dimensions is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3. And the City of San Antonio will convey to the United States Government a triangular tract of land off of the south side of New City Block 425 and part of East Houston Street, **East Houston Street, 34.8 feet on the west side of** about 114.5 feet on the **northside** of Avenue E, the said line on East Houston Street intersecting the line on North Alamo Street at right angles, said tract containing approximately 883.00 square feet, a plat reflecting the above figures and dimensions is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

4. The Mayor of the City of San Antonio is hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary instruments looking to the exchange of properties with the United States Government as above set out when and if the Congress of the United States shall authorize the carrying out of that part of the agreement obligating the granting of land as above stipulated; provided, however, that if the Congress of the United States should fail and refuse to authorize the granting of land by it, such failure and refusal shall not in any way affect the granting of the easement by the City of San Antonio pertaining to that part of the land situated on the south side of City Block 425, and which property shall not project farther than 12 feet into Alamo Plaza at

the widest part of the triangular part of property granted as an easement.


5. This ordinance is passed as a matter of public necessity and convenience, to improve traffic conditions and increase the safety for the users of the public streets of the City of San Antonio, and in order to aid the United States of America in the design of the postoffice.

6. PASSED AND APPROVED this 14th day of October, A. D. 1933.




