

AN ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING \$1435.00 TO PAY SPECIAL POLICEMEN FOR SERVICES RENDERED AT THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That \$1435.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1938 General Fund - Judgments & Suits Department, to pay 287 special policemen \$5.00 per day for services rendered to the City of San Antonio in the Municipal election on the 9 day of May, 1939, which special policemen were deemed necessary by the Mayor to preserve the peace of the City, and who were duly appointed by the Mayor.

2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

3. PASSED AND APPROVED this 25 day of May, A.D. 1939.
