4th. A Resolution Authorizing and directing the Commissioners of Streets and Public Improvements to take such steps as may be necessary for the widening and straightening of South Alamo Street between East Commerce Street and a point opposite the intersection of South Alamo and Refugio Streets.

AN ORDINANCE

MH-379 REPEALING AN ORDINANCE LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE WIDENING OF SOUTH ALAMO STREET.

1. WHEREAS, heretofore the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio passed an ordinance levying special assessments for the improvement of South Alamo Street by widening; and,

2. WHEREAS, many property owners have filed protest as to the amounts of assessment, and estimated as damages to be paid for the acquisition of property; and,

3. WHEREAS, it appears to the Commissioners that the total cost of the project is excessive and the amounts of the benefits are not fair and ratable;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

4. That the certain ordinance, passed and approved on the 24th day of August, A. D. 1927, and recorded on page 125-28 of Volume "H", Minutes of the Proceedings of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, entitled "An Ordinance levying special assessments on account of the improvement of South Alamo Street, by widening and straightening it from the south line of East Commerce Street to the north line of East Nueva Street; providing for the issuance of assessment certificates, etc.", be and the same is in all things hereby repealed and declared of no effect.

AN ORDINANCE

REPEALING AN ORDINANCE APPROVING REPORT AND ROLL OF THE CITY ENGINEER, WITH REFERENCE TO THE IMPROVEMENT OF SOUTH ALAMO STREET.

- 1. WHEREAS, heretofore the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio passed and ordinance approving report and roll of the City Engineer, with reference to the improvement of South Alamo Street; and,

AN ORDINANCE

ALLOTING CERTAIN SUMS, AS THE CITY'S PORTION, FOR THE WIDENING AND OPENING OF MAIN AVENUE, SOUTH ALAMO STREET AND DOLOROSA STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

That the Auditor be and he is hereby directed to set aside out of moneys voted for the widening and opening of streets, in separate accounts, the following sums, as the City's portion, to be used on the following streets, viz:-

Main Avenue - - - - -	\$350,000.00
South Alamo Street - - - - -	250,000.00
Dolorosa Street - - - - -	80,000.00

and expended by appropriate ordinances heretofore or hereafter enacted.
