## AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating Fifteen Hundred Dollars to refund the City Water Board for one-half of sum advanced, in settlement of suit No. B-52525, in the 37th District Court, John R. McCutcheon v. H. H. Bryant and City of San Antonio, et al.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars be and the same is appropriated out of the 1928 General (City Clerks Department) Fund, to refund the City Water Board for one-half of sum advanced (\$3000.00) in settlement of John R. McCutcheon vs. H. H. Bryant and City of San Antonio, et al., being No. B-52525 on the docket of the 37th District Court, Bexar County, Texas, growing out of an alleged injury because of defective condition of street on East Quincy Street, in San Antonio, Texas, in April 1928.
