

AN ORDINANCE 2007-05-22-0589

CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 12, 2007; ORDERING A RUN-OFF ELECTION FOR CITY COUNCIL DISTRICTS 5 AND 8 TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 12, 2007; AND ESTABLISHING EARLY VOTING AND ELECTION DAY POLLING LOCATIONS FOR THE RUN-OFF ELECTION.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the Joint General and Special Election was held on Saturday, May 12, 2007, to determine the Mayor and Council Members of the City of San Antonio, and for consideration of five propositions; and

WHEREAS, at the May 12, 2007 Election, the voters of the City of San Antonio were asked to elect members of the City Council for Places 1 through 10, each member to be elected by a majority vote of the qualified electors voting in the election in the particular district, and to elect a Mayor (Place 11) who is to be elected by a majority of all qualified electors voting in the election; and

WHEREAS, the voters of the City were also asked to consider individually five bond propositions: Proposition 1 - Streets, Bridges and Sidewalks Improvements; Proposition 2 - Drainage Improvements; Proposition 3 - Parks, Recreation, Open Space, and Athletics Improvements; Proposition 4 - Library Improvements; and Proposition 5 - Public Health Facilities Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the names of the candidates and the propositions were submitted to the voters, the election was held and conducted and the returns were made, all as required by the City Charter and the laws of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and investigated all matters pertaining to the election, including the ordering, notices, election officers, holding and returns, and it is now necessary to declare the official results of the canvass; and

WHEREAS, in the May 12, 2007 General Election, no candidate for the Office of Council Member for District 5 or District 8 received a majority of votes for the office sought, and therefore no candidate was elected for these places; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to order a Run-off Municipal Election for Tuesday, June 12, 2007, for the purpose of electing Council Members for Places 5 and 8; and

WHEREAS, it is also necessary to establish Early Voting and Election Day polling sites for the Run-off Election, and to take other actions related to the May 12, 2007 General and Special Election and the June 12, 2007 Run-off Election; **NOW THEREFORE:**

SECTION 3. As a result of the May 12, 2007 General Election, the following individuals were elected Council Members for a two-year term commencing June 1, 2007:

SECTION 4. It is further declared that as a result of the May 12, 2007 General Election, no candidate for Places 5 and 8 received a majority of all votes cast by qualified voters of the City voting in the election, as required by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, and therefore, no candidate was elected for Member of Council for these places. The two candidates in each district receiving the highest number of votes for each place in the May 12, 2007 General Election shall again be voted upon at the June 12, 2007 Run-off Election. A Run-off Election will be necessary so that the candidate receiving the highest number of votes shall have received a majority of all the votes cast for the office.

SECTION 5. A Run-off Election for the purpose of electing members of the City Council of the City of San Antonio for Places 5 and 8 is hereby ordered to be held in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas on the 12th day of June, 2007, in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas and the provisions of the Charter of the City of San Antonio. The official ballots for the June 12, 2007 Run-off Election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code. The two candidates who received the highest number of votes for Place 5 and Place 8 shall again be voted upon at the Run-off Election.

SECTION 6. Early voting for the Run-off Election shall begin on Saturday, June 2, 2007 and end on Friday, June 8, 2007. The hours of early voting and the early voting polling sites for the Run-off Election are set out in **Exhibit A**, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 7. The Election Day polling sites for the June 12, 2007 Run-off Election are set out in **Exhibit B**, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 8. Voting for the Tuesday, June 12, 2007 Run-off Election shall be conducted by the use of iVotronic voting machines and by AIS650 Tabulators and paper ballots, as determined by the City Clerk of the City of San Antonio and the Bexar County Election Administrator. The AIS650 Tabulators and paper ballots shall also be used for the casting of early votes by mail, for early voting by personal appearance, and for provisional voting.

SECTION 9. Electors may cast their early vote by mail, and the Early Voting Clerk's mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail shall be sent to, is as follows:

The last day to receive an application for a ballot to be voted by mail is Tuesday, June 5, 2007 by 5:00 P.M.

SECTION 10. (a) *Form of Notice of Election.* The City Clerk of the City of San Antonio is hereby authorized and directed to prepare a form of the Notice of Election in both English and Spanish, the contents of which comply with the requirements of Section 4.004 of the Texas

Election Code (and all other applicable law), and include at a minimum, the nature and date of the election, the location of each election day and early voting polling place, the hours the polls will be open, the locations, dates, and times of temporary branch locations of early voting by personal appearance, the early voting clerk's mailing address, and any other information required by other law, and with such variations permitted by applicable law.

(b) Method of Giving Notice. Notice of the June 12, 2007 Run-off Election shall be given by posting a copy of the Notice of Election, both in English and in Spanish, not later than the 15th day before the date set for the election, on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the City Council of the City. Notice of the Run-off Election shall also be given by publishing the Notice of Election, both in English and in Spanish, at least once, not earlier than the 30th day or later than the 10th day before Election Day, in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of San Antonio. It is hereby found and declared that the San Antonio Express-News is a newspaper of general circulation within the City.

SECTION 11. The City Council, after canvassing the returns of the May 12, 2007 Special Election, does hereby find and declare that the following votes were cast at the Special Election on the submitted PROPOSITIONS by the resident, qualified electors of the City who voted at the election, and declare the results of the election to be as follows:

STREETS, BRIDGES, AND SIDEWALKS IMPROVEMENTS PROPOSITION

PROPOSITION NO. 1

“Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$306,997,413 for the purpose of making permanent public improvements for public purposes, to wit: providing streets, bridges, and sidewalks improvements (as well as necessary improvements incidental thereto), relocating utilities, street lighting, technology improvements, and signage, and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary for streets, bridges, and sidewalks?”

“Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$152,051,818 for the purpose of making public improvements for public purposes, to wit: providing drainage improvements and facilities for the removal of, and protection from, harmful excesses of water, whether constant or periodic, any other drainage or stormwater improvements, and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto?”

"Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$79,125,293 for the purpose of making permanent public improvements for public purposes, to wit: acquiring, constructing, equipping, and renovating park, cultural, recreation, open space, and athletics improvements, making park additions, and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto?"

LIBRARY IMPROVEMENTS PROPOSITION

PROPOSITION NO. 4

"Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$11,025,476 for the purpose of making permanent public improvements for public purposes, to wit: acquiring, constructing, improving, renovating, and/or equipping library facilities, and/or other learning center facilities to be utilized as libraries, and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto?"

PUBLIC HEALTH FACILITIES IMPROVEMENTS

PROPOSITION NO. 5

"Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$800,000 for the purpose of making permanent public improvements for public purposes, to wit: constructing, improving, renovating, and equipping health facilities available to the general public and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto?"



SECTION 12. The City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares the result of the May 12, 2007 Special Election to be that : **Proposition 1 - Streets, Bridges and Sidewalks Improvements; Proposition 2 - Drainage Improvements; Proposition 3 - Parks, Recreation, Open Space, and Athletics Improvements; Proposition 4 - Library Improvements; and Proposition 5 - Public Health Facilities Improvements**, so submitted to the voters, were each approved and have each received a favorable majority in all respects and have carried.


SECTION 13. The City Council hereby finds that pursuant to such election, the voters of the City have, as a result of the May 12, 2007 Special Election, authorized the City Council to issue \$550,000,000 of general obligation bonds, and to levy and pledge the tax in payment thereof, in accordance with the authority granted in each of the respective Propositions and with law.



TOTAL PRECINCT: The entire precinct is geographically located within the City Council District and all the residents are represented by the elected Council Member of that District.

SPLIT PRECINCT (*SPLIT): A precinct that is not totally in the City limits of San Antonio. Parts of the precinct may be shared by other communities or unincorporated Bexar County. These may include right-of-way and parts of the City.

RIGHT-OF-WAY (ROW):** These are precincts which are City limit extensions of major highways and roads due to annexations. Only the right-of-way is in the City limits and does not have any residents.
