AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO EXECUTE DEED FROM THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO ALBERT RAMIREZ.

The following ordinance was read the second time and laid over: "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE, SHOOTING, DISCHARGING, EXPLODING, IGNITING OR DISPLAYING ANY FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND CONTAINING A SAVING CLAUSE AND CREATING AN EMERGENCY."

Commissioner Hein introduced the following ordinance which was read the first time and laid over:
 "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBDIVISIONS (a) AND (b) OF SECTION ONE, AND SUBDIVISIONS (a), (d), (k) and (m) OF SECTION TWO OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING NOISE NUISANCE; SPECIFYING CERTAIN ACTS CONSTITUTING NOISE NUISANCES AND PROVIDING THE SAME SHALL NOT BE EXCLUSIVE; DEFINING CERTAIN TERMS: REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A PENALTY AND CONTAINING A SAVING CLAUSE", PASSED AND APPROVED DECEMBER 30TH, A.D.1937.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police, Anderson.

Petition of the Texas Company to install two electric computing pumps at 2822 North Flores St., replacing two old electric meter pumps now installed at this location.

Petition of The Texas Company to install two 280-gal. underground gasoline storage tanks at service station located at 802 Nogalitos Street.

A hearing was granted to Manuel C. Vidal upon his appeal from the action of the Taxicab Inspector in suspending him as a Taxicab Driver in the City of San Antonio, for the reason that he had heretofore been convicted of law violations in the Federal Court of this District.

Upon motion of Commissioner Anderson, duly seconded, the decision of the Taxicab Inspector was upheld, and the appeal denied by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Davis, Hein, Steffler and Anderson.
