MONDAY, FEBRUARY 20TH, A.D.1922, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable O. B. Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Pfeiffer, Rieden, Wright. Absent, Lambert.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

## -----MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS-----

Petition of San Antonio Trades Council requesting passage of ordinance regulating the construction of chimneys was read and referred to the City Attorney, and the Commissioner of Fire and Police.

Petition of Flora K. Adams regarding sale of property to City on Wilmington Avenue was referred back to the City Attorney for further investigation.
