## ---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police:

McDaniel and Kahn Oil Co. for permit to erect two 8000 gal oil tanks.

For arc light at Victoria and Indianola Streets.

For arc light at Park and San Pedro Avenues.

E.J. McNerney, for permit to convert Hippodrome into moving picture show.

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The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements:

Petition to have part of Courtland Place gravelled and rolled.

Ben A. Stribling, requesting adjustment of a paving assessment against Lot A-18.

Mrs. Margaret Knight, requesting reimbursement of money expended for the construction of a Sanitary Sewer.

No. 282 **MC-687** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$4454.64 to pay J. Depuy.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Forty Four Hundred and Fifty Four and 64/100 (\$4454.64) Dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to be paid to J. Depuy as a final estimate on the cost of construction of the sidewalk running along the East bank of the San Antonio River, between Houston Street and Travis Street.

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No. 283 **-688** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$10,856.92 to pay Decarie Incinerator Company and S.A. Machine and Supply Company.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$10,856.92 or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Garbage Incinerator Fund to pay Decarie Incinerator Company and San Antonio Machine and Supply Company first estimate on construction of the second unit of the Incinerator Plant as per statement of the City Engineer filed in the office of the City Auditor.

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No. 284 **-689** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$47.00 out of the Trench Maintenance Fund to pay men.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Forty Seven (\$47.00) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Trench Maintenance Fund for the purpose of paying the men for repairing trenches.

No. 285 **MC-690** AN ORDINANCE

Directing the payment of salaries and wages for services rendered by officers and employes of the City for the month of December, 1918, and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated for the payment of officers and employes for the several accounts and departments as specified in the attached schedule as salaries and wages for services rendered to the City during the month of December, 1918, as per pay rolls.

Appropriating \$2756.47 to pay special pay rolls for the week ending December 14, 1918.
