REVISING CHARGES RELATED TO CITY-OWNED PARKING  
LOTS, GARAGES AND PARKING METERS AND AMENDING  
SECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE SETTING OUT SUCH  
CHARGES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Section 19-199 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended to read as follows, additions being underlined and deletions being ~~struck through~~:

(j) A one-time fee reduction of twenty dollars (\$20.00) is authorized to provide an incentive for monthly customers to participate in an electronic payment program.

**SECTION 2.** Section 19-221 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is hereby amended to read as follows, additions being underlined and deletions being ~~struck through~~:

Sec. 19-221. Operation of meters.

When any vehicle shall be parked in any parking space alongside or next to where a parking meter is located, the operator of such vehicle shall, upon entering the parking meter space, immediately deposit or cause to be deposited in said meter the proper coin or coins of the United States of America in the form of nickels, dimes, or quarters, as are required for the desired parking time at such meter and as are designated in the directions on the meter. The parking meter space may then be occupied by one vehicle during the meter indicted parking time. The proper money amount required for the use of parking meters spaces are as follows:

(a) *One-hour parking meters:* The required amount of money for the use of a parking meter space within the maximum sixty (60) minutes parking zone shall be:

(b) *Two-hour parking meters:* The required amount of money for the use of a parking meter space within the maximum one hundred twenty (120) minutes parking zone shall be:

(c) *Ten-hour parking meters.* The required amount of money for the use of a parking meter space within the maximum ten (10) hour parking zone shall be as follows:

**SECTION 3.** If any part of this Ordinance, or any appendix hereto, for any reason, is held illegal or invalid, or any exception to or limitation on any general provision contained in this Ordinance or its attachments is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder nevertheless stands effective and valid as if it had been enacted and ordained without the portion held to be unconstitutional or invalid.


**SECTION 4.** The City Clerk for the City of San Antonio is hereby directed to publish notice of this Ordinance as required by the Charter of the City of San Antonio and the laws of the State of Texas.

**SECTION 5.** It is officially found, determined and declared, as a matter of legislative finding, that the meeting at which this Ordinance is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including consideration and adoption of this Ordinance was appropriately given, all as required by law, including Texas Government Code Chapter 551.


**SECTION 6.** All other provisions of Chapter 19, City Code of the City of San Antonio remain in full force and effect except as expressly amended by this Ordinance, but this clause does not impair the effect of another ordinance enacted contemporaneously with this Ordinance.

**SECTION 7.** The effective date for imposition of the fees enacted herein is October 1, 2009, otherwise, as soon as legally permissible on or after October 1, 2009.




