Attached hereto you will find a quitclaim deed which is self-explanatory.

Please prepare an ordinance rescinding Ordinance #10924 of November, 1949, and appropriating \$10 to Elisha Thompson and wife, Sue Thompson as full consideration for the quitclaim deed. The ordinance should also accept the quitclaim deed.

The object of the quitclaim deed and the ordinance is to clarify for the records the details of this transaction and restore the property on the tax rolls to the City's name. Apparently, the Tax Office shows the property in the Thompsons' name as a result of the original ordinance which made and manifested the deed. The whereabouts of the original ordinance is unknown. The attorney who was handling the transaction for the Thompsons died before the deal was consummated, and it may have been in his hands at that time, or it may have been submitted to a title company. There is nothing in the City Clerk's files to indicate what happened to it. We do know that the Thompsons did not pay the money to the City, so the transaction was not completed.
