AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH WILSON AND WERNER TO PLAN THE COMMUNITY BUILDING FOR MITTMAN PARK; AND APPROPRIATING \$500.00 THEREFOR.
