AN ORDINANCE 11,781

AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE
CAUSE NO. F-38,848 IN THE 73RD DISTRICT
COURT OF BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS, ENTITLED
CLARENCE D. RUTLEDGE VS. CITY OF SAN
ANTONIO, ET AL: APPROPRIATING THE SUM
OF \$400.00 OUT OF ACCOUNT "JUDGMENTS
AND SUITS" OF THE 1949 GENERAL FUND;
AND PRESCRIBING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS
OF SAID SETTLEMENT.

WHEREAS, Section 47 of the City Charter provides that the Commissioners may compromise suits filed or pending against the City upon recommendation of the City Attorney, upon the filing by the City Attorney with the City Clerk his reasons in writing for such compromise; and

WHEREAS, such letter has been so filed in the case herein mentioned, and, Whereas the City Attorney disclaims any liability in this litigation but recommends that such case be compromised to avoid further expense of litigation and to eliminate the uncertainties thereof, and

WHEREAS, the Plaintiff in such cause has agreed to accept the sum of \$400.00 in full settlement upon his claim in excess of \$7,000.00, the City of San Antonio to pay Court Costs which have accrued to date; and, WHEREAS, the City Attorney states in writing that under the Circumstances this settlement should be effected and recommends said settlement. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the City Attorney be, and he is hereby authorized, to compromise and settle cause No. F-38,848, Clarence D. Rutledge vs. City of San Antonio, pending in the 73rd District Court of Bexar County, Texas, the City to pay the accrued costs.

The Sum of \$400.00, is hereby appropriated out of Judgments and Suits of the 1949 General Fund, said money to be paid to the Plaintiff upon his delivering to the City a release in form satisfactory to the City Attorney.

2. City of San Antonio hereby disclaims any legal liability in this litigation and this settlement is authorized only in the spirit of compromise to avoid the further time and expense necessary to litigating said suit, and because of the recommendation of the City Attorney that, under the circumstances, said suit should be settled for the small sum agreed upon.

3. The City will pay the accrued costs of Court upon the entry of final judgment in this case.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE PASSED AND APPROVED 3 NOVEMBER, 1938, ESTABLISHING ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH AN COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE HEIGHTH, NUMBER OF STORIES AND SIZE OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES; PER CENT OF LOT THAT MAY BE OCCUPIED; THE SIZE OF YARDS, COURTS AND OPEN SPACES; DENSITY OF POPULATION; LOCATION AND USE OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES AND LAND FOR TRADE, INDUSTRY, RESIDENCE AND OTHER PURPOSES; DIVIDING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO INTO DISTRICTS, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, RE-CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, REPAIR OR USE OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES OR LAND WITHIN SUCH DISTRICT; PROVIDING THE UNIFORM REGULATIONS FOR CLASES OR KINDS OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES AND USES WITHIN THE RESTRICTED DISTRICT; ADOPTING ZONING MAP DISCLOSING VARIOUS DISTRICTS, USE, AREAS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS AND PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO DISTRICTS and areas; PROVIDING FOR A BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND DEFINING THE POWERS THEREOF; TO RE-ZONE: PROPOSITION A, PORTION OF WEST HOUSTON STREET; PROPOSITION C, PORTION OF MERIDIA STREET; PROPOSITION D, PROPERTY ON WEST COMMERCE, MATYEAR AND WEST MARTIN STREETS; PROPOSITION E, PROPERTY IN WAREMOORE ESTATES; PROPOSITION F, PORTION OF BLANCO ROAD. ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS ORDINANCE OR THE OWNER OF ANY BUILDING OR PREMISES OR PART THEREOF WHERE ANYTHING IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE PLACE OR SHALL EXIST, AND ANY ARCHITECT, BUILDER, CONTRACTOR, AGENT, PERSON OR CORPORATION EMPLOYED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, WHO MAY HAVE ASSISTED IN THE COMMISSION OF ANY SUCH VIOLATION SHALL BE GUILTY OF A SEPARATE OFFENSE AND UPON CONVICTION MAY BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$100.00 AND EACH DAY SUCH VIOLATION EXISTS SHALL CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE OFFENSE. PASSED AND APPROVED 2 MAY, 1950.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That an ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, ETC." passed and approved by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio on the 3rd day of November, A. D. 1950, be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

2. PROPOSITION A;

"To re-zone a portion of West Houston, as "H" LOCAL RETAIL DISTRICT, as follows:

Lot A-1, A-2,3,4 and 5 New City Block 2291, on the south side of West Houston Street.

3. PROPOSITION C:

"To re-zone a portion of Meridia Street, as "F" LOCAL RETAIL DISTRICT, AS follows:

Lot 1,47,48 and 49,50 New City Block 3690

4. PROPOSITION D;

"To re-zone property on West Commerce, Matyear and West Martin Streets, as "J" COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, as follows:

The area bounded on the south by the "J" Commercial District on West Commerce Street, on the north by West Martin Street, on the west by Matyear Street, and on the east by N.W. 26th Street.

5. PROPOSITION E:

"To-Zone property in Waremoore Estates, as "F" LOCAL RETAIL DISTRICT, as follows:

The West 407 Feet of New City Block 9800 and 9802
Lot 13 New City Block 9469
West irregular 309 feet of New City Block 9497

6. PROPOSITION F:

To re-zone a portion of Blanco Road, as "J"COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, as follows:
Lot 10, New City Block 7220 was denied, and the zoning of said Lot 10, New City Block 7220 on Blanco Road, shall remain "B" Residential District.

7. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

8. The Building Inspector is ordered to change his records and zoning maps accordingly.

9. This ordinance being of urgent importance to the public peace, health and safety of the City of San Antonio, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a four-fifths vote of the Commissioners, and signature of the Mayor, as made and provided by the Charter of the City of San Antonio.

10. The City Clerk shall publish the descriptive caption of this ordinance which states in summary the purpose of the ordinance and the penalty for violation thereof, 10 times in the "COMMERCIAL RECORDER", a newspaper published in the City of San Antonio.

That this permit is intended to cover only the sewerage from the property of the Licensee, as same is now situated on said premises at Number 807 Elizabeth Road, Lot East 25' of 24, all of 25 and West 10' of 26, Block 4, County Block 5526, Terrell Hills and no other person shall be permitted to use the said City sanitary sewers through the connection hereby made.

5. That the future owner of the above property shall comply with all the provisions hereof, and the conditions are covenants running with the land.

9. The City of San Antonio shall never be liable to the Licensee for pecuniary damage for failure to take and treat the sewerage of the Licensee, and said right of action is waived as a part of the Consideration of this permit.
